# 2.1.1 Applied Sciences **Department**

The Department of Applied Sciences teaches and promotes practical aspects of Applied Sciences to build a solid foundation as part of the Engineering Education. Applied science is a discipline of science that applies existing scientific knowledge to develop more practical application like technology or invention. The department prepares students for core engineering branches by educating them in the basic sciences of physics, chemistry mathematics and English communication skills in the first year. The laboratory and classrooms are provided as per A.I.C.T.E. norms. Physics encompasses the study of the universe from the largest galaxies to the smallest subatomic particles. Physics is the basis of many engineering courses. Like Physics, many of engineering subjects depend on chemistry. The faculty members are committed to the students and Improved methods of teaching and learning process are adopted to achieve learning abilities through practice, exposure and motivation. Mathematics is



indispensable for the engineering community. Students use mathematics to understand and solve engineering problems. The English Communication skills laboratory is an integral part of the department. Students receive training in written and verbal communication essential to succeed in the work place. Computer facility, charts, special instruction room, preparation room, HOD and staffroom are incorporated. Ventilation and sufficient light, fans, fire extinguisher's, glass board are used in the lab and class accordance with prescribed syllabus.





# 2.1.2 Civil Engineering Department

Considered the most versatile branch among all the engineering branches, Civil Engineering is running in this institute from inception since 2009. It is the branch with lot of diversity right from structural to

transportation engineering, environmental to hydrology to hydraulics engineering, geology to geo-technology to earthquake engg. Being one of the primary engineering department of the institute, the department of civil engineering offers B.Tech & M.Tech degrees. There are five assistant professors in civil engg having good experience of teaching. The department has well equipped laboratories in the specialized areas to fulfil the needs of the students. We have various labs such as structural analysis, geotechnical engg, transportation engg, surveying, concrete technology, environmental engg, hydraulics

& civil softwares. The major equipments in the labs are digital pH meter, turbidity meter, aggregate impact test apparatus, los Angeles test apparatus, total station, three hinge arch apparatus, beam apparatus, bench type consolidometer, permeability apparatus, theodolite, triaxial compression test apparatus etc. There are 135 students studying in the civil engineering department at present.






# 3. ADMISSIONS

Admission to SIRDA is possible through various entrance examinations, like the Joint Entrance Examination (JEE), Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE), PAT and HPCET, for its various degrees and diploma programmes. Scholarships are given to all meritorious and needy / poor students belonging to weaker sections of the society. Deserving students are also given fee concessions and other benefits.









#### 3.1 Post Graduate Programme (M.Tech)

- The admission to M. Tech degree courses shall be made on the basis of merit of valid GATE-2016 score.
- In case the seats remain vacant after exhausting the merit of GATE, the vacant seats will be filled up on the basis of merit of HPCET-2016.

Note:- The minimum/cut off marks to seek admission to M. Tech degree course on the basis of HPCET-2016 and B.E./ B.Tech. Examinations shall be as follows:

#### 3.2 Undergraduate Programme

#### 3.2.1 B.Tech

- The admission to the first 50% of the seats shall be made on the basis of merit/rank/score obtained in JEE (main)-2016. The remaining 50% seats will be filled up on the basis of merit of hpcet-2016.
- In case the seats remain vacant after exhausting the merit of JEE (Main) and HPCET, the remaining seats

will be filled up on the basis of merit of 10+2 examination conducted by a recognized board or university.

Note:- The minimum/cut off marks to seek admission to B.Tech degree course on the basis of JEE (Main) -2016, HPCET-2016 and 10+2 shall be as follows:

#### 3.2.2 B.Tech Lateral Entry (2nd year)

The candidate having passed 3 years diploma in engineering with 50% marks (45% in case of reserved categories) are admitted in 2nd year (3rd semester) in respective branches of engineering on the basis of criteria as fixed by the H.P. Technical University Hamirpur.

#### 3.3.3 Diploma in engineering and pharmacy

The admission shall be made strictly on the basis of merit of marks obtained in PAT-2016 conducted by H.P. Technical Education Board.







In case, seats remain vacant after exhausting the merit of PAT, vacant seats will be filles up amongst the candidates obtaining 50% marks (45% for reserved categories) at minimum entry level qualification prescribed by H.P. Technical Education AICTE from time to time.

The minimum eligibility criteria for admission to 2nd year in Polytechnic under Lateral Entry Scheme is that the candidate must have passed 12th in Science Stream/12th with Vocational or/ 12th Science with Technical or/10th + (2 years ITI/COE) with appropriate specialization as per AICTE Norms. The admission shall be made strictly on the merit of marks

obtained in Lateral Entry Entrance Test (LEET-2016) conducted by H.P. Takniki Shiksha Board Dharamshala. In case, seats remain vacant after exhausting the merit of LEET-2016, vacant seats will be filled up amongst the candidates obtaining at least 50% marks (45% for resrved categories) at minimum entry level qualification prescribed by AICTE from time to time.

The minimum eligibility criteria for admission to 1st Year D.Pharmacy is that the candidate must have passed 12th in Science stream from a recognized Board.









# 4. Faculty

The faculty of SIRDA is not only considered amongst the best regionally, but is also highly recognised nationally for its achievements in the field of education and research. At present, there are nearly 80 faculty members in the institute (in the year 2006-17). There is a conscious continuous effort by the institute to widen its faculty base and add greater variety and depth to the scope of teaching, and also to the R&D experience. # 6. ATTENDANCE


Students are expected to maintain discipline within the institute campus & follow the instructions issued by the administration from time to time.

SIRDA has wellequipped laboratories with state-of-the-art facilities. There are undergraduate teaching laboratories as well as sophisticated research facilities.








### 7.3 Library

# 10. CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

A student shall conform to a high standard of discipline and shall conduct himself, within and outside the precincts of the Institute, in a manner befitting the students of an Institution of national importance.

- He shall show due courtesy and consideration to the employees of the Institute and Halls of Residence, good neighborliness to his fellow students, respect to the Wardens of the Halls of Residence and the teachers of the Institute and pay due attention and courtesy to visitors.



# 11. SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE

The SIRDA Skill Development Centre under the Construction Sector Skill development has been accredited and affiliated where the TOA and TOT programmes are undergoing successfully. The campus of 30,000 sqft built up area including administrative block, smart classroom labs and hostel area and Also 15000 sqft open yard hand on practice area is independently earmarked and designated for this purpose, which is annexed to the campus of the other institutions having opportunity of additional support and advantage of this infrastructure. This skill development centre fulfils all the parameters of Smart centre and qualifies five star grading.













### 12. ANTI- RAGGING POLICY

Ragging is banned in the Institute. If a student is found to have indulged in ragging in the past, or if it is noticed later that he/she has indulged in ragging, then he/she may be expelled from the Institute. The anti-ragging squad shall work in co- ordination with the anti-raggingCommittee and oversee the implementation of the recommendations of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Punishments: depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as

Established by the anti ragging committee of the university, the possible

Punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the college level shall be any one

Or any combination of the following:

- 1. Cancellation of admission.
- 2. Suspension from attending classes.
- 3. Debarring from appearing in any tests /examinations or other evaluation process.

- 4. Withholding results.
- 5. Debarring from representing the college in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- 6. Suspensions/expulsions from the hostel.
- 7. Rustication from the college for period varying from 1to 8 semester.
- 8. Rigorous imprisonment of three years and / or a fine of upto Rs. 50,000/
- 9. Could be handed over to police (penalty: 2 years in prison as per government rules).
